Presenting a wedding day token is an adaptation of a 16th century French custom that was generally reserved for royalty. The objects given to guests at a royal wedding were originally of great value - gold, precious stones or porcelain. As the tradition was introduced into society, gifts of lace, glass or confections were substituted.

Sugar coated almonds tied in netting can be placed by each plate; chocolate roses, medallions or truffles are becoming very popular. You might choose a single fresh flower; a lace rose filled with potpourri or a packet of seeds.
